

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Each year the Wauna Credit Union (WCU) Scholarship Committee determines the number and amount of scholarships awarded. Scholarships are given for post-high school education and may be used for tuition, room, board, books, and fees.

SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE IS APRIL 12, 2024.

ELIGIBILITY

Recipients must be graduates of, or on track to graduate from, any high school and a member of WCU. There will be no discrimination as to race, creed, color, national origin, religion, or gender of the applicant. Recipients may be former winners of this scholarship with payment made for the second, third, or fourth year of school. Recipients must be enrolled a minimum of half-time at their academic institution during the year in which the WCU scholarship is awarded.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a member in good standing with WCU.
- The WCU application form attached shall be used; others will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.

Please make sure to include:

- One copy of your FAFSA report showing your EFC (Expected Family Contribution)
- One official transcript from your high school and/or college
- Enclosed pages outlining extracurricular/community activities
- The enclosed section outlining your future goals and objectives
- Two letters of reference — preferably one letter from a teacher and one from a community leader or other personal reference who knows you outside of school

Well rounded activities showing community involvement and a well-developed application will be given higher priority in the application process. The scholarships granted shall be awarded at graduation or awards assembly as per each school's policy. The WCU Scholarship Committee shall make the final decision as to the recipients of the scholarships. Checks shall be made payable to the the educational institution by WCU. If the recipient elects not to attend or not to continue in school, the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate recipient chosen by the committee. Recipients must submit proof of enrollment before scholarship funds will be awarded to the educational institution.
